I will be generous with praise and set a good example.

I will obtain the required coaching certification and continue to strive to upgrade my coaching skills beyond the minimum requirements.

I will work in cooperation with officials for the benefit of the game.

I will work in cooperation with other coaches/parents who have volunteered their time to assist my efforts.

I will respect the playing facilities provided for my team and our opponents, and I will inspire my team to show the same respect.

I agree to abide by the principles of the Northwest Calgary Ringette Society's Fair Play Pledge and the Ringette Alberta Code of Conduct and Ethics and understand that a failure to do so may result in the suspension of my coaching privileges.
