Registration

Definitions

Refer to the Northwest Calgary Ringette Society (NWR) Bylaw definitions.

The following terms have these meanings in this Policy:

Individuals means all categories of Membership within the NWR Bylaws, as well as all individuals engaged in activities with NWR, including but not limited to, athletes, coaches, parents/guardians, volunteers, managers, administrators, directors, and officers.

Non-Playing Athlete means a player who registers to play with NWR, but who becomes unable to participate in game play for the entirety of the registered season. Such players may participate in team activities including on-ice practices but may not participate in game play of any kind, i.e., Ringette Alberta sanctioned events or any out-of-province games including exhibition or tournament games.

Registration Dates & Deadlines

1. Refer to the [Ringette Alberta Registration Policy](#).
2. All players registered with NWR must have their fees paid in full, or have made payment arrangements, prior to the start of the season with the Registrar.
3. Players/families registered with NWR are required to complete the association-level volunteer bond or pay the volunteer bond fee if electing to not complete an association-level volunteer role, as set out in the Rate & Fee Schedule.
 - a. Refer to NWR12 Volunteering policy.
4. Registration dates and deadlines will be posted on the NWR Registration webpage.
5. Registrations will not be accepted after the close of registration unless NWR determines there is room in an age division. Players may be waitlisted.
6. Players in the U14, U16 and U19 divisions who are intending to participate in AA evaluations MUST also register with NWR to secure an evaluation spot with NWR in the event that the player is not placed on a AA team.

Registration Fees

7. Registration fees will be determined in conjunction with developing the budget for the season which is approved at a board meeting following the NWR Annual General Meeting each year. Registration fees are posted on the NWR website Registration webpage in the Fee Schedule for that season prior to registration opening.
8. NWR fees include:
 - a. Ringette Calgary or Chinook Ringette League fees
 - b. Regional fees for U12
 - c. Session 3 fees for U14 to U19
 - d. Community fees for Huntington Hills and Triwood catchments
 - e. One individual and team photo from NWR photo night(s)
 - f. Team Snap subscription
9. Refunds
 - g. Refund requests to NWR must be done in writing to registrar@nwringette.com.
 - h. Refer to the Rate & Fee Schedule for current refunds offered by NWR.

Registration Boundaries**Players within NWR Boundaries**

Player registration is open to those individuals residing within the boundaries as set by Ringette Calgary for NWR. At present, this includes all communities north of Memorial Drive from the west city limits to Deerfoot Trail AND Crestmont AND all communities north of McKnight Blvd from Deerfoot Trail to the east city limits.

Players outside of NWR Boundaries (Out-of-bounds)

10. Players whose home association is not NWR will follow the residency procedures set by Ringette Alberta.
11. Players whose home association is not within NWR boundaries can evaluate with NWR if their home association does not offer a tier that is available with NWR, or approval may be granted on a case-by-case basis by NWR.
12. Players who are evaluating for a higher tier must rank as a secured player within that tier to be eligible for a NWR team. If a player does not rank as a secured player, they may play in a lower tier if this is approved by NWR and they obtained a release from their home association.
13. NWR may take a maximum of two out-of-bounds players per team at all tiers except the lowest tier for that age division.
14. Out-of-bounds players will be required to pay an evaluation fee as set in the Fee Schedule. If the player is released to NWR, that fee will be applied towards their registration fee.
